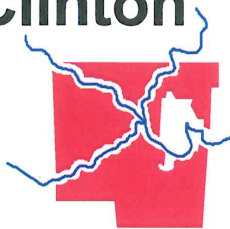

## **Save the date – Clinton Township recognizes fifteenth anniversary of 9/11 on Patriot Day**

Please join Clinton Township Supervisor Robert Cannon on Sunday, September 11th at 7 p.m. at The Annual Clinton Township Patriot Day Ceremony on the grounds of Resurrection Cemetery, located at 18201 Clinton River Road (between Garfield and Romeo Plank).

This year's event commemorates the fifteenth anniversary of September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks on the United States.

Guest speakers will include Macomb County Executive Mark Hackel, Macomb County Sheriff Anthony Wickersham, and a representative of the Clinton Township Police Department. In addition, the ceremony will include the CTPD Honor Guard, VVA 154 Honor Guard, and musical selections sung by the Serenity Choir of St. Michael's Church.

"Clinton Township held its first ceremony to commemorate Patriot Day on the Friday after the attacks in 2001 and I am proud that we've held a ceremony on September 11 of every year since," said Supervisor Cannon.

"We've always honored our first responders, as well as those who died during the attacks, and our military. This year we will continue to honor all three, with an emphasis on our daily protectors—particularly the police—who are currently facing unprecedented duress in their profession as they continue to show up to work each day and put their lives on the line—just like they did on September 11th, 2001," he said.

Supervisor Cannon looks forward to seeing many friends and neighbors on Patriot Day, as the township recognizes the many men and women who lost their lives on that tragic day fifteen years ago.
